Entries will may NOT be accepted without full payment of all fees and without using the Dressage on the First Coast Entry Form. To download a Dressage on the First Coast entry form visit www.dressageonthefirstcoast.com. **Please DO NOT use the Dressage Omnibus Entry Form.** Management retains the right to refuse any entry, use substitute judges and combine or split classes as entries warrant. Include copies of all USEF and USDF cards (horse, rider, owner, and trainer) and Coggins, to be retained by show management. **\$10 refund** will be distributed with packet for fully complete and correct entries as required on the Dressage on the First Coast Entry Form. Sorry, NFDA does not accept credit cards.

Refunds: Full refunds before closing date, minus office fee. Notification must be made in writing to secretary, either by mail or email by the rider, owner, or trainer only. **NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE, INCLUDING USEF ART. 311.**

Times: Tentative ride times will be available on **March 29th** online at www.dressageonthefirstcoast.com and by phone **April 1st** from the Show Secretary at (352) 466-3538. All ride times (including pre-printed show program) are to be considered tentative until each morning of the show. **Consult posted times at the Show Office each day on grounds for up-to-date times!** Riders competing more than two (2) horses will be required to sign a waiver allowing shorter times between rides than those specified by USEF if such is necessary to accommodate show schedule.

Stabling: Stalls available for \$95 for the weekend (includes 2 bags of shavings). 280 12' x 12' and 149 10' x 10' permanent stalls with sliding doors, electricity and nearby water faucets. Nails and screws are prohibited from use in the stalls. Cable ties, duct tape, over stall hangers, pushpins, and small staples are permitted. Removal of the mentioned items are the responsibility of the competitors. All horses on grounds must be stabled. Two bags of shavings provided for all horse stalls (\$16 value) (excludes tack stalls). Additional shavings may be purchased on the show grounds for \$8 per bag. No shavings may be brought in from off-site. No horses will be accepted for stabling or schooling until 1:00pm Friday, April 4th. All horses must depart by 8:00pm on Sunday, April 6th. Thursday or Sunday overnight accommodations may be arranged by calling the Jacksonville Equestrian Center directly at (904) 573-4895. Parking allowed around the barn for unloading and loading purposes only. All vehicles and trailers must be moved to designated locations. Illegally parked vehicles will be towed at owners' expense.

Arenas/Footings: One indoor arena, other arenas and warm up outdoors – special sand mixture or turf/rubber footing. All arenas 20m

X 60m. Quality freestyle sound system.

Rules / Whips: All USEF rules apply; FEI rules will supersede USEF rules where applicable.

COMING INTO FLORIDA FROM THE NORTH:

Take 95 SOUTH to 295 SOUTH, 14.5 miles to Interstate 10 WEST, 4.8 miles to the Chaffee Road Exit # 351. Turn right off the ramp, go 3 miles and turn right on Normandy Blvd. (State Road 228). The Jacksonville Equestrian Center is located 4.3 miles on the right side of Normandy Blvd.

COMING NORTH FROM SOUTH FLORIDA:

Take 95 NORTH, 77.2 miles to 295 NORTH, 15.6 miles to the 103rd. Street (State Road 134) Exit 16. Turn left off the ramp, go 7.8 miles and turn right on New World Ave. Go one block and turn left on Normandy Blvd. (State Road 228). The Jacksonville Equestrian Center is 1 mile on the right hand side of Normandy Blvd.

COMING INTO FLORIDA FROM THE WEST:

Take Interstate 10 EAST to the Chaffee Road Exit # 351. Turn left off the ramp, go 3 miles and turn right on Normandy Blvd. (State Road 228). The Jacksonville Equestrian Center is located 4.3 miles on the right hand side of Normandy Blvd.

COMING FROM THE OCALA AREA:

Take US 27 NORTH, 0.5 miles to US 301. Keep straight onto US 301, 22.5 miles. Turn right onto US 301 NORTH, 51.3 miles, turn right onto Normandy Blvd. (State Road 228). The Jacksonville Equestrian Center is located 6.6 miles on the left hand side of Normandy Blvd.

COMING SOUTH ON US 301 INTO FLORIDA:

10.8 miles to Callahan, Fl. and turn right on US 301 SOUTH to Baldwin, Fl., 20 miles, and turn right to stay on US 301 SOUTH. Go 1 mile and turn left to stay on US 301 SOUTH. Go 6.4 miles and turn left onto Normandy Blvd. (State Road 228). The Jacksonville Equestrian Center is located 7.3 miles on the left hand side of Normandy Blvd.

Motorized Vehicle Statement: In accordance with GR 1401.29:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include the exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Other: Food concession on the grounds. Veterinarian on call and Farrier on call – numbers to be posted at Show Office. Photographer on grounds – sign up directly with photographer in vending area (not at the Show Office).

Dogs: All dogs must be on leashes at all times with a maximum leash length of 6 feet. No dogs are allowed in the Indoor Arena (City of Jacksonville Ordinance).

Veterinarian & Farrier: The show veterinarian and farrier will be on-call with names and contact phone numbers posted at the show office.

Notice: The Northeast Florida Dressage Association, the Jacksonville Equestrian Center, SMG, the City of Jacksonville, their officials, owners, employees, agents, and guests will not be held responsible for accidents or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectators, guest, rider, groom, other employee, animal or equipment at the competition. All exhibitors, spectators, guests, grooms, or other employees are subject to the rules and regulations of NFDA and the Jacksonville Equestrian Center.
