DRESSAGE SUITABILITY / EQUITATION: Walk-Trot and Walk-Trot-Canter

JUMPERS *will be run in accordance with USEF --- see www.usef.org for rules and scoring*

Regular Jumpers: 2', 2'3", 2'6" – Table II format (clear first rounds jump off for time)

Crossrails: 12", 18" – must trot between fences, placed by time plus faults (no jump off)

All riders jumping an obstacle of any kind must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets with the chinstrap fastened.

FUN CLASS: Mounted cake walk! Have some fun and win a sweet treat for yourself and your horse. Just \$5 per rider!

AWARDS:

All classes – ribbons 1st-6th place

Special prizes for High Score Jr. & Sr. Dressage

Team: ribbons to all members of 1st and 2nd place teams



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

DRESSAGE TEAM COMPETITION

- Teams may be made of 3 or 4 riders.
- All scores from each team member will count towards the team's accumulated score.
- No scores will be dropped.
- Each team's accumulated score will be divided by the number of rides made by its members to get the team's average score.
- Average scores will be used to determine placings.
- Will not be divided according to age.
- \$5 per rider - Sign-up sheets for teams will also be available at check-in.

CLOSING DATE / CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY

- **Closing date is absolutely firm.** If insufficient complete entries to cover show expenses have been received by 5pm on the Closing Date, the show will be cancelled.
- Late entries (after 5pm on Closing Date) may be accepted at show management's discretion with a \$25 late fee. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- If the show is cancelled by show management for any reason, pre-paid entries will be refunded at the highest possible percentage after non-recoverable show expenses have been met.
- Entries scratched, cancelled, or otherwise withdrawn by the rider after the Closing Date will not be refunded.
- Jumper, Dressage Suitability, Dressage Equitation, or Fun Class entries may be added the day of the show with no late fee IF the rider already has a paid entry submitted by the Closing Date for classes at that show and the class was not dropped from the schedule due to insufficient pre-paid entries.

HOUSE RULES:

1. NO DOGS! Leashed or otherwise they will not be allowed on the premises.
2. All riders must wear protective headgear when mounted. Juniors must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets with the chinstrap fastened.
3. Management reserves the right to divide or combine classes, if necessary, as needed.
4. Jumper and Fun classes with less than 3 pre-paid entries will be cancelled.
5. Dressage Suitability and Dressage Equitation classes with less than 2 pre-paid entries will be cancelled.
6. Be safe, courteous, and above all – HAVE FUN!!!

DIRECTIONS TO TRINITY FARM

From Valdosta – Take I-75 South to State Road 6, go west (right) onto 255 North. Go north 1/2 mile, the farm will be on the left.

From I-10 & Lake City – I-10 west toward Tallahassee. Exit north (right) on 255 (Lee, FL exit). Head north about 7 miles until you cross SR 6. Continue on 255 for 1/2 mile, the farm will be on the left.

From Tallahassee – I-10 East to 255 (Lee, FL exit). Head north on 255 about 7 miles until you cross SR 6. Continue on 255 for 1/2 mile, the farm will be on the left.

****SUWANNEE VALLEY CHAPTER of DSDCTA RELEASE FORM****

Know all men by these presents, that I, the undersigned (hereinafter referred to as "participant"), desires to engage in and does hereby engage in the following equine activity, to wit the **Suwannee Valley Chapter of Deep South Dressage & Combined Training Assn. Fall Frolic Horse Show on November 14, 2009, located at Trinity Farm, Lee, FL.** Participant does for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, waive and release any and all claims for damages, death, personal injury or loss of property against the Suwannee Valley Chapter of the Deep South Dressage and Combined Training Association, also known as SVCDSRCTA, it's officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives, which may arise from participating in or observing equine activities at or sponsored by SVCDSRCTA, even if caused in part by the negligence or negligent actions or other fault of the parties or persons I am release, or by the dangerous or defective condition of any property or equipment owned, maintained or controlled by them. My participation in or observation of equine activities at or sponsored by SVCDSRCTA are done at my own risk. I understand that equine activities are potentially hazardous and that I should not participate in these activities unless I am medically able, properly trained and appropriately supervised. I attest that I am physically fit and sufficiently trained for the activities that I participate in that occur at or are sponsored by SVCDSRCTA. I fully understand I am forever giving up in advance any right to sue or make claims against the parties I am releasing if I suffer injuries or damages. I will assume my own medical and emergency expenses in the event of an accident or other incapacity of injury resulting from or occurring in my participation in or observation of equine activities sponsored by SVCDSRCTA.

For in consideration of the above activities, services and entry fees paid, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Participant hereby does forever and finally release, remise acquit, satisfy and forever discharge the Equine Activity Sponsor of and from all manner of action and actions, cause and causes of action, suit, debts, dues, sums of money, bonds, billings, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, damages, variances, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law and equity, which may arise or might in the future arise or hereinafter may arise for or against the Equine Activity Sponsor for the activities as stated above .

Further, I understand that the above hold harmless agreement does additionally apply in whole and full to the owners, managers, lessor, and lessee of the physical property upon which the event will be held, said property being commonly known as Trinity Farm, David J. and Linda L. Boyles, Owners, located in Lee, FL.

This document is meant to be a full complete release from any and all liability that may arise from participating in the above-described equine activity. This release is given freely and voluntarily by the participant and is meant to remain in existence throughout the duration of the equine activity.

Under Florida Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Florida Statutes, 1993, Title XLV Torts Chapter 773 Equine Activities.
